Leonard Clarence "L.C." Williams was born August 6, 1949 in Rockdale to Lon and Ardie Mae (Parker) Williams. After graduation he attended the University of North Texas. On August 28, 1972 he and Margaret Ann Williams were married in Austin. They lived in Austin from 1971 until they moved to Del Valle in 1999. L.C. worked as an engineer with Texas Parks and Wildlife for 28 years. Two of his favorite projects were restoration of the Texas State Cemetery and the Battleship Texas. He retired in 2011 and after retirement he spent most of his time in Burleson County on their ranch. He was a member of Pecan Street Church of Christ in Rockdale. He was an original member of The Souls of Motion Motorcycle Club Austin.

L.C. loved being in the country hunting and fishing. He loved spending time with his "Babygirl", granddaughter Kyndall, teaching her to drive the tractor and four-wheeling.

He passed away Saturday morning, August 21, 2021 at his ranch in Burleson County at the age of 72. He is preceded in death by his parents, Lon and Ardie Williams and a brother, Joe Williams.

Surviving is his wife, Margaret Ann Williams; son, Byon Williams and wife Jacqui; brother, Lon Williams, Jr. and wife Barbara, and granddaughter, Kyndall Williams along with a host of nieces and nephews.
