



Lewis Donald "Don" Hubert

May 8, 1930 - September 4, 2019

Funeral services for Lewis Donald "Don" Hubert will be 3:00 p.m. Saturday, September 7, 2019 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with Minister Gene Van Noord officiating. Burial will follow in the Minerva Cemetery. Visitation will also be Saturday from 2:00 p.m. until service time at 3:00 p.m.

Lewis Donald "Don" Hubert was born May 8, 1930 in Minerva to Ralph and Jessie (Lewis) Hubert. He served in the U.S. Air Force for 20 years and retired as a Master Sergeant on August 31, 1966. During his career he lived in France from 1959 to 1964, Fairfield, California from 1964 to 1967 and Oxnard, California from 1967 to 2002. He was a Weapons Specialist and a Top Secret Nuclear Weapons Specialist. He knew where all the nuclear weapons were located throughout the world. Because of that knowledge, he was not allowed to fly over certain countries. After the Korean Conflict, he helped build orphanage homes in South Korea. After his retirement, he worked two years for the U.S. Air Force. On July 31, 1952, he and Araminta Talboy were married in Oakland, California. They have lived in Rockdale the past 17 years.

Don passed away Wednesday morning, September 4, 2019 at his home in Rockdale, reaching the age of 89. He was preceded in death by his wife, Araminta "Vi" Hubert on June 7, 2003; two daughters, Donna Lynn Mary Hubert and Denise Diana Austin; his parents Ralph Hubert and Jessie Gore;

three brothers, Hoyle D., Ralph Byron and Charles "Cotton" Hubert and six sisters, Florene Fletcher, Ara Bell Hubert, Mae Agnes Van Meter, Bonnell Gjedde, Doris McCutcheon and Jessie Lou Neatherlin.

Surviving are daughters, Barbara Darnell Jensen and husband Bruce of Santa Barbara, California and Sharyn Hubert of Rockdale; Son-in-law, Fred Austin of Yorba Linda, California; Brother, Jack Hubert and wife Lou of Bryan; Sister, Margaret Hubert Denman of Minerva; Eight grandchildren, Brandi, Travis, Brian, Brad, Michelle, Tyler, Brittany and Cassidy and five great grandchildren, Annabelle, Mason, Savannah, Cade, Julia, Ethan and Meagan.
