



## Lillie Mae House

March 28, 1939 - October 21, 2019

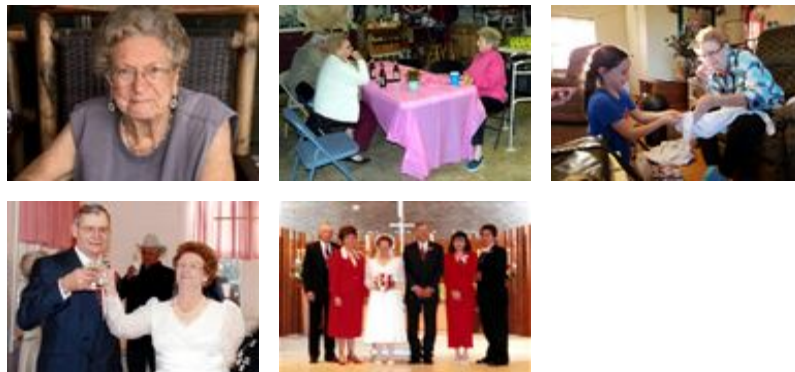
