She attended school at Prospect in Griffin Chapel. The school later consolidated with Milano where she attended and was a 1946 graduate. She was baptized into Christ at Sandy Creek Church of Christ near Milano. She later placed her membership at Pecan Street Church of Christ in Rockdale and remained a faithful and supportive member until her health declined. She and William L. Moore, her high school sweetheart, were married September 30, 1947 in Cameron. In 1968, she began her thirty-three year career in the nursing home industry. Starting at Boswell's Nursing Home and later Manor Oaks Nursing Center where she worked until her retirement on June 30, 2001. During her career, she was a cook, a certified dietary supervisor and a dietary assistant. After retirement, she began writing the community news for the Rockdale Reporter, beginning with current events and later added segments on the history of the Griffin Chapel Community. Lillie enjoyed attending worship service, reading, especially the Bible, cooking, solving word and picture puzzles, watching game shows, playing dominoes

and spending time with her family. Lillie passed away Thursday, June 20, 2013 in the Winnie L. Nursing Home in Cameron.
