Linda Beth (Becker) Beasley, beloved wife, mom, grandmother and friend passed on Monday, November 6, 2023 at 11:51 pm, at home surrounded by family. Linda was the latter, and fighting tirelessly and courageously against colon cancer since being diagnosed in November 2017.
