October 7, 1930 - September 19, 2016

Memorial services for Lois Lantz, age 85 of Rockdale, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Sunday, September 25, 2016 in the First Presbyterian Church in Rockdale. Rev. David Pussman of First Presbyterian Church will officiate. The Lantz family will receive friends at the church after the memorial service.

Lois was born October 7, 1930 in Buffalo, New York to Carl Bennet and Beulah (Wills) Schumacher. She graduated high school in Massena, New York. She received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Home Economics from Cornell University and then her Master's Degree in Home Economics from St. Lawrence University. She taught school for five years and retired in 1959. On June 21, 1958, she and Glade Lantz were married in Massena, New York and later moved to Rockdale. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Rockdale.

Lois passed away Monday afternoon, September 19, 2016 at her home in Rockdale. She was preceded in death by her son, Carl Bennet Lantz and her parents.
