



Lorene Emily Sump

May 30, 1922 - February 24, 2019

Funeral services for Lorene Sump, 96, of Giddings, Texas are scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 27, 2019 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, February 26, 2019 from 3:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, February 27, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Tuesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Lorene Emily Aschenbeck Alexander Sump was born on May 30, 1922 in Giddings, Texas, the daughter of Otto Edwin Aschenbeck Sr. and Hulda (Kriegel) Aschenbeck. She was baptized on June 22, 1922 and confirmed on March 21, 1937 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings. Her confirmation verse was John 3:16, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life". Lorene was united in marriage to Tommie Alexander in November of 1944. They had two sons, Tommie and Douglas. Lorene worked for several years in the cafeteria at Giddings ISD. Following Tommie's death in 1962, Lorene married Carlie Sump on July 8, 1969. After their marriage, they moved to Conroe. While living in Conroe, Lorene worked as a dietitian at the Conroe hospital. A few years after Carlie's death, she moved back to Giddings. She was an active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church where

she was a member of the Singles for Jesus group and enjoyed attending Bible studies. Lorene was also a member of the Lee County Seniors in Action. She was a member of a local bowling team and bowled up until she was 89. She enjoyed gardening, canning and playing dominoes. Lorene also believed in bringing something to everything she attended and many of her baked items were enjoyed at the various meetings, parties and other events she attended. She passed away the morning of Sunday, February 24, 2019 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

Lorene was preceded in death by her parents; both of her husbands, Tommie Alexander Sr., and Carlie Sump; her three brothers, George, Alvin and Otto Aschenbeck Jr. and one granddaughter, Haley Alexander Singer.

She is survived by her two sons, Tommie Alexander & his wife, Carol of Victoria and Doug Alexander & his wife, Nancy of Giddings; one step-daughter, Carlene Sump Richie of Mesa, Arizona; four grandchildren, Steven Gerhardt & his wife, Kimberly of Cypress, Candice Alexander of Giddings, Marcos Alexander & his wife, Brandy of Houston and Tara Steubing & her husband, Jacob of Huntsville; nine great grandchildren as well as several nieces and nephews.

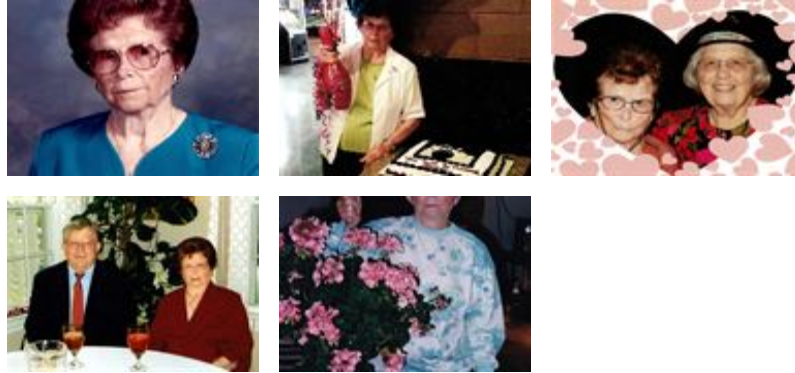
