



LouAnn Zunker

October 16, 1957 - April 8, 2015

A celebration of life memorial service and motorcycle ride for LouAnn Zunker will be held 12 Noon Saturday April 18, 2015 at the Apache Pass Steakhouse, 9132 North FM 908, Rockdale, Texas.

LouAnn passed away Wednesday, April 8, 2015 from a motorcycle accident in Comal County while coming back home to Rockdale from her place in Bandera to visit and enjoy a motorcycle ride.

She was born October 16, 1957 to Bobby and Barbara (Guinn) Goodwin in San Antonio. LouAnn loved to ride her "trike" and she also enjoyed making beaded jewelry and Southwestern type jewelry including the jewelry she is wearing in the picture. LouAnn was the featured "Cover Girl" of the Easyrider Magazine in the March 1983 edition. She represented Texas in the centerfold photo shoot that was titled "Texas Gal", with four pages of beautiful photos. She was later honored with being selected for the 1987 Easyrider's Photo Calendar, featured as the month of September photo girl. She also was featured in other special publications being so beautiful and so photogenic. Being selected as "girl of the year," she was flown to California for a photo shoot and was well paid by the Publishers. Few, if any, can make such a "claim to fame." She had also participated in Mission trips to the Southwest especially in New Mexico.

On February 14, 1988, she and Michael Zunker were married. He preceded her in death on March 17, 2011 and also by her father, Bobby Goodwin and her brother, Steve Goodwin.

Surviving LouAnn is her mother Barbara Priest of Rockdale; four children Mellissa Ison Zawadzke of Rockdale, Clayton McDowell of Cedar Creek, Kimberley McDowell of Goldthwaite and Weldon Zunker of Bandera; two brothers David Goodwin of Galveston and Jeff Goodwin of Bryan; four grandchildren Stefan Hinojosa of Rockdale, John Thomas Zawadzke of Rockdale, Natalie Gallardo of Goldthwaite and Piper Rivera of Goldthwaite; nieces and nephews and more dear family and friends than anyone can count.

LouAnn was a "star", a beautiful person and her memory lives on with those who knew her, and share a love of riding motorcycles, friendships and brotherhood.

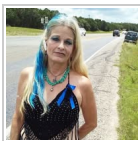
