He was a member of CAPCOG, Texas Justice of the Peace and Constables Association, Central Texas Justice of the Peace and Constables Association, served as OSHA Safety Officer for Lee County and the Emergency Management Coordinator for Lee County and he helped establish the Lexington EMS. Louis enjoyed raising cattle and riding horses. He was very devoted to the Lee County community and looked forward to all of the

community events. He loved to spend time with his family and friends.

Buster passed away the morning of Friday, March 9, 2018 at North Austin Medical Center in Austin.
