



Louis Sherman Gaeke

March 31, 1931 - December 4, 2024

Funeral services for Louis Gaeke, 93 of Giddings, will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 29, 2024 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner and Rev. Joshua Hahn officiating. A private burial will be held at Giddings Memorial Park.

Louis Sherman Gaeke was born on March 31, 1931 in Chicago, Illinois, the son of Louis Henry Gaeke and Anna (Farrack) Gaeke. His family moved to Texas shortly after his birth. He was baptized on April 12, 1931 in Bellwood, Illinois by Rev. Kufsky and confirmed on April 14, 1946 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Max Studtmann. His confirmation verse was 2 Peter 3:18, "But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever! Amen". Louis graduated from Giddings High School in 1949. On December 30, 1950, Louis was united in marriage to the love of his life, Colene Dunn. They were blessed with two sons, Robert and Douglas. He began working with Droemer Construction in Giddings and in 1961, he started his own company, Gaeke Construction Company, which continues to operate to this day. Louis always took an active role in his church and community. Through the years he served as a Boy Scout leader, Lee County Little League officer, was instrumental in the creation and construction of the Giddings Golf Course, was a former director of First National Bank in Giddings and a member of the Giddings Rotary Club. He was a huge Texas A & M fan and loved watching and supporting the

Aggies. Louis was an active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings where he helped to construct the existing sanctuary in 1960 and took great pride in the fact that 60 years later, his company was the contractor for the current building program at the church. The Brookwood Community in Brookshire held a special place in the hearts of both Louis and Colene. Not only did Louis construct most of the buildings at the complex, he and Colene were both huge supporters of the facility, volunteering their time and resources to help support the facility's mission throughout the years. Though Louis spent most of his life in construction, his legacy isn't the structures he built. Rather it is the family he and Colene created and the community which he helped to build.

Louis passed the evening of Wednesday, December 4, 2024 at Bec's Blessing in Giddings.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Louis & Anna Gaeke; his beloved wife of 70 years, Colene Gaeke and two brothers, Edmund Gaeke and William "Willie" Gaeke.

Louis is survived by his two sons, Robert "Bob" & Debbie Gaeke of Boerne and Doug & Lisa Gaeke of Giddings; his four grandchildren, Brandon & Misty Gaeke of Boerne, Brent & Jessica Gaeke of Boerne, Audra & Kyle Braden of Frisco, and Drew & Emily Gaeke of Giddings; his seven great grandchildren, Anna Gaeke, Wyatt Mayberry, Beau King, Charlotte Braden, Boone Gaeke, Violet Braden, and Brooke Gaeke; his two sisters, Lucille Brannon of Brenham and Virginia & Charles Vavrecka of Pearland, as well as many other family members and friends.

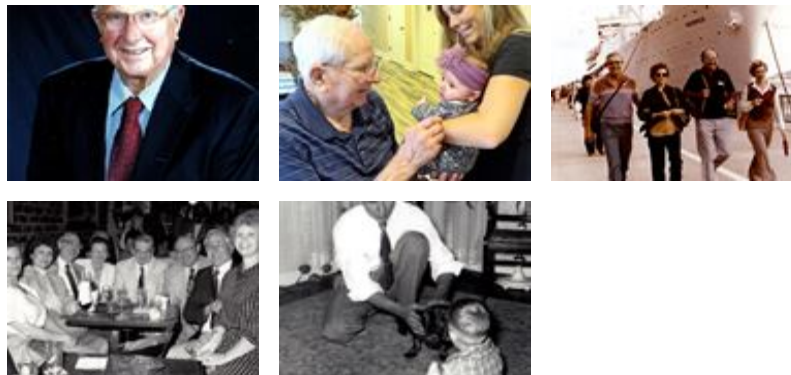
