Louis Edwin Wagner was born on August 7, 1924 in Clifton, Texas to Reinhold A. & Wilhelmina (Harms) Wagner. He was baptized on August 14, 1924 in Clifton, Texas and confirmed on March 21, 1937 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Houston by Rev. Arthur J. Meyer. Louis served in the U.S. Army Air Force from November 3, 1942 until receiving his Honorable Discharge on October 20, 1945 having obtained the rank of Corporal.
