



Louise Gesine Anna Medack

February 9, 1917 - August 6, 2014

Louise Gesine Anna Medack was born in Lee County, Texas on February 9, 1917 to Gustav Henry Namken & Ella Martha (Bergt) Namken. She was baptized on March 4, 1917 and confirmed on March 29, 1931 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. William Mueller. Louise married Albert Medack on September 10, 1939 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church with Rev. William Mueller officiating. Together they spent 66 years together farming, ranching and gardening. She is fondly remembered by her family for her quilting, gardening, dill pickles and coffee cake.

Louise passed away the morning of Wednesday, August 6, 2014 at the Giddings Residence and Rehabilitation Center in Giddings at the age of 97 years, 5 months and 28 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Gus & Ella Namken; her husband, Albert Medack; her brothers, Eddie, Erwin and Roland Namken and her son-in-law, Henry Umscheid.
