



Lucille Alene Wagner

October 6, 1948 - November 16, 2023

Funeral services for Lucille Wagner, 75 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 21, 2023 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau, Texas with Rev. David Mumm officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Lucille Alene (Schulze) Wagner was born on October 6, 1948 in Loebau, Texas, the daughter of Paul Gerhard Schulze and Bertha Louise (Pampell) Schulze. She was baptized on October 17, 1948 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau by Rev. Herbert Hartfield and confirmed on April 7, 1963 also at Christ Lutheran Church by Rev. Louis Boriack. She attended school in Dime Box and graduated from Dime Box High School. On July 9, 1967, Lucille was united in marriage to Glenn Wagner at Christ Lutheran Church by Rev. Andrew Szegedin. They were blessed with two children, Hope and Hoyt. Lucille worked at the Lee County Tax Office for 33 years. She was a lifelong and active member of Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau where she had served as the president and the secretary of the Ladies Aid. She also volunteered with the church's annual turkey dinner and in the hamburger stand during the church picnic for many years. She enjoyed reading, cooking and taking care of her dogs. Lucille was a caregiver, and she was happiest when taking care

of and spending time with her family, especially her two grandsons.

Lucille passed away on Thursday, November 16, 2023 at Baylor Scott and White Medical Center in Brenham.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Gerhard & Bertha Schulze; her sister and brother-in-law, Bernice & Edmund Iselt; two sisters-in-law, Ellen Schulze and Shirley Zwernemann, and a nephew, Troy Zwernemann.

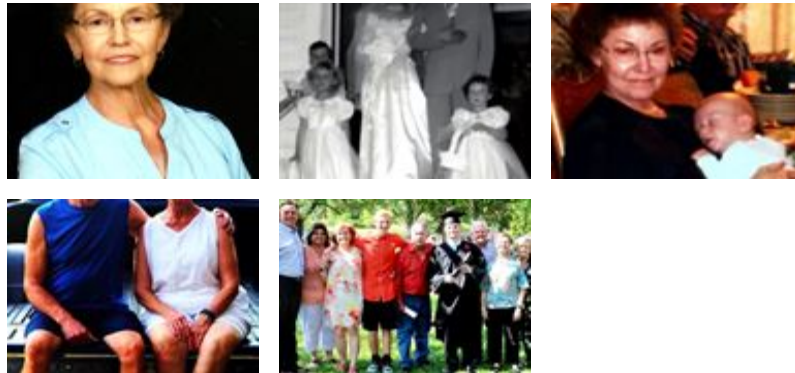
