



## Ludwig Carl Krause

December 26, 1937 - May 4, 2025

Funeral services for Ludwig Krause, 87 of Northrup, Texas are scheduled for 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 10, 2025 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Thursday, May 8, 2025 from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m., on Friday, May 9, 2025 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday, May 10, 2025 from 7:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation both Thursday and Friday evenings from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Ludwig Carl Krause was born on December 26, 1937, in Northrup, Texas, to Carl Herbert Krause and Olga Marie (Menzel) Krause. He was baptized on January 1, 1938 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt and confirmed on April 6, 1952 also at St. Paul Lutheran Church by Rev. Arthur Arndt. His confirmation verse was Psalm 37:5, "Commit thy way unto the Lord; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass." On September 21, 1958, Ludwig married the love of his life, Edna Leona Kasper, in her home church, St. Michael's Lutheran Church, in Winchester, Texas. Their love endured and spanned throughout their lifetime, and to this union, seven children were born, Daniel, Michael, Carolyn, Curtis, Susan, Debra, and Peggy.

Ludwig and Edna made their home at Ludwig's family farm in Northrup where

they raised their family and lived all of their life. He was an active member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas and was a big supporter of the South Lee County Volunteer Fire Department. Ludwig provided custom hay baling and farming services for many years and also worked on his own farm, demonstrating meticulous attention to the maintenance of his equipment. He retired from Cargill Nutrena in Giddings after 28 years of dedicated service. Ludwig was an accomplished self-taught accordion player for over 47 years. His trademark "smooth" accordion playing could be heard with the Ellinger Combo Orchestra, later known as the Central Texas Sounds. Ludwig and Edna maintained a large garden to feed their family and made delicious noodles for many years. Ludwig enjoyed watching TV game shows, baseball, playing 42 and solving word search puzzles, but what he enjoyed the most was watching his grandchildren at their sporting events and school activities.

Ludwig passed away on Sunday, May 4, 2025, at his home in Northrup, the same home he was born in 87 years earlier, with his family by his side.

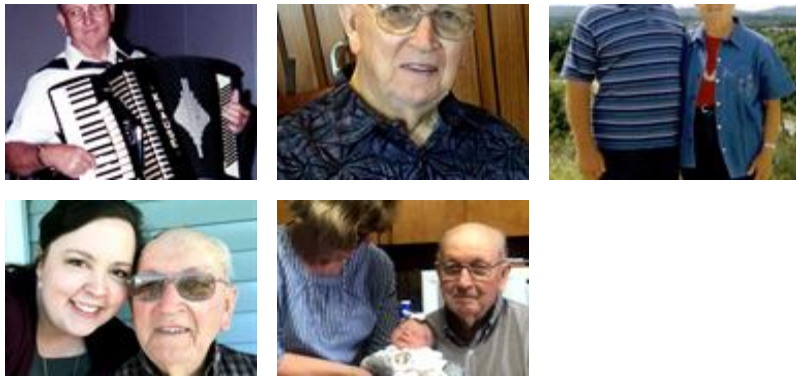
