She also worked at the Miller Mill Works, owned and operated with help from her sons the Modern Variety Store then for Preuss Dry Goods and I.G.A. Grocery all in Lexington. She was a ranch owner, a driver for Lexington Senior Citizens taking seniors to doctor's appointments and other places of interest. She was an election pole watcher and a precinct judge for Lee County. Lydia was known for her homemade pecan pies and was a caretaker for her grandchildren, especially the grandsons during the summer time. She was a member of Lexington United Methodist Church, the United Methodist Women and a member of Red Hat Society. Lydia passed away Tuesday night February 4, 2014 in the Regent Care Center in San Antonio. She was preceded in death by her

husband Burnie on December 15, 1997; her parents; sister, Hertha Wurzbach and brother, Herbert Schroeder. Surviving are three sons, Burnie Allen Miller and wife Rose of San Antonio, and their children, Sharon Curry, Machele (Micki) Cevallos, Burnie Miller, Jr. and Mark Miller, son Stanley Miller and wife Joan of Georgetown, and their son Jason Miller, son John Miller and wife Gail of Cypress, and their children, Matthew Miller and Julie Eaton.
