Maegan Ellen Sanders, 22, of Lexington, was called to heaven too early in a tragic accident with her brother, Wesley, on Sunday, December 1, 2019.

Always the academic, her most memorable moments were placing first in UIL Accounting at the State meet and being Valedictorian of her graduating class. She was currently attending Texas A&M University at Mays Business School where she was set to graduate in May 2020 with bachelor degrees in Accounting and Business Honors and a Master's in Management Information Systems. During her time at A&M she was also a member of Group 27 in the Professional Program in Accounting (PPA).

Maegan spent her last few months here on earth happily engaged to Cameron Janda who she planned to start a life with while working for Ernst & Young in

San Antonio.

Maegan was preceded in death by her grandfathers, Donald Thummel and Edmund Truex.
