



## Magdalena "Lena" Selma Fischer

Funeral services for Magdalena "Lena" Fischer, 78, of Giddings are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, May 2, 2014 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Rev. Jeremy Walloch officiating. The family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Mrs. Fischer passed away the afternoon of Tuesday, April 29, 2014 at her home in Giddings following a battle with cancer. Magdalena Selma (Miertschin) Fischer was born on September 23, 1935 in Warda, Texas to Martin & Selma (Bigon) Miertschin. She was baptized on September 29, 1935 and confirmed on April 10, 1949 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda, Texas by Rev. Paul C. Eifert. Her confirmation verse was Isaiah 45:10, "For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my people be removed, saith the Lord that hath mercy on thee." Lena was united in marriage to Marvin Charles Fischer on November 27, 1958 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas by Rev. Arthur A. Arndt. Their union was blessed with two children, Allan and Theresa. Lena was a loving and devoted homemaker to her family and an active member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings where she had served as a Sunday School teacher and the Stewardship Chairman. She was also a member of the Ladies Aid and volunteered with Vacation Bible School and

helped with the church's walk-in coffees. Lena enjoyed gardening and fishing. She was preceded in death by her parents, Martin & Selma Miertschin; an infant brother, Paul Miertschin; her sister and brother-in-law, Erna & Jimmy Klander; her brother-in-law, Royce Zoch; her niece, Caryn Zoch Neumann; her nephew, Bobbie Klander; her great niece, Katherine Neumann and her parents-in-law, Ernest & Minnie Fischer.
