



Mandy "Dolly" Ann Price

April 10, 1921 - November 15, 2014

Funeral services for Mandy Ann "Dolly" Exner Price, 93 of Lexington, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 18, 2014 at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington with Rev. Carl Roth officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, November 18, 2014 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings.

Dolly passed away on Saturday, November 15, 2014 at St. David's North Austin Medical Center in Austin, Texas.

Mandy Ann "Dolly" (Exner) Price was born on April 10, 1921 in Giddings, Texas to Samuel Otto & Theresa Marie (Noack) Exner. She was baptized on May 1, 1921 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas by Rev. Reinhard Osthoff and confirmed on March 25, 1934 at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, Texas by Rev. C.W. Rische. Her confirmation verse was Revelations 3:11, "Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown". Dolly was united in marriage to George Linvell Price on May 11, 1946 at Walker Avenue Baptist Church in Houston. She was a supervisor in a bakery in Dallas for many years. Dolly was a member of St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington and enjoyed taking care of animals, especially dogs and cats.

She was preceded in death by her husband, George Linvell Price; her parents, Samuel Otto & Theresa Marie (Noack) Exner; four sisters, Mary Exner, Elna Exner, Lillie Glona and Ruby Lerche; three brothers, Herbert Exner, Theodore "Ted" Exner and Leroy Exner and a nephew, Chester Exner.

Dolly is survived by two sisters, Clara Pecht of Houston and Irene Nittsche of Fedor; sister-in-law, Esther Exner of Lincoln as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

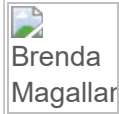
