He owned and operated this business for over 40 years pouring his last slab in January of 2024. Marcus wore a belt buckle that said "All Around Cowboy" but those that knew him, knew him as much more than that. He was a father, mentor, teacher, cattleman, rancher, and a businessman as well as many other things. Marcus was a workaholic always working on something, but on the occasion that he wasn't working he enjoyed

fishing, hunting, and ranching. He loved working with his family in their cattle business as well and you never found him without a pen in his pocket.

Marcus passed away the afternoon of Friday, February 16, 2024 at his ranch in Buckholts, Texas with his wife by his side.

He is preceded in death by his parents Edwin and Ruby Lerche.

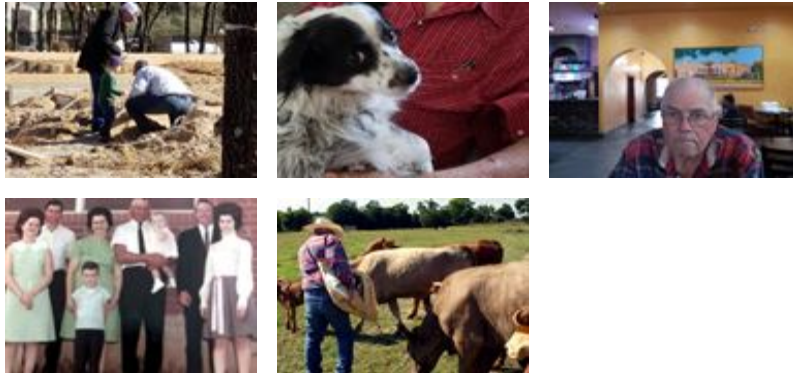
