Margaret Lucille (Hoffman) Walther was born on March 4, 1945 in Giddings, Texas, the daughter of William "Bill" & Lillie (Lindner) Hoffman. She was baptized on April 29, 1945 in the Methodist church and confirmed into the Lutheran faith on May 14, 2006 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings. She graduated from Giddings High School in 1963 and went on to receive her Associates Degree from Blinn College. Margaret was united in marriage to Cecil Walther on June 22, 1966 at the First United Methodist Church in La Grange, Texas. They were blessed with two sons Tim and Chad. She was a longtime member of the First United Methodist Church in Giddings before joining Immanuel Lutheran Church. Margaret worked as a teachers aid and librarian for the Giddings Independence School District before joining the Insurance Network of Texas team working on commercial accounts. She was very active with the PTA while Tim and Chad were in school. Margaret was an

amazing homemaker who loved cooking and always kept an immaculate and beautiful home. She enjoyed playing golf, traveling, and both flower and vegetable gardening. More than anything, she enjoyed spending time with and spoiling her grandchildren. Margaret will be remembered as a loving wife, mother, grandmother, and sister who had the strongest faith and was always willing to lend a helping hand.

She passed away the evening of Thursday, September 16, 2021 at St. David's Medical Center in Austin.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Bill & Lillie Hoffman; her parents-in-law, Herbert & Myrtle Walther; her sister and brother-in-law, Elaine & Maury Crow; her brother, James Hoffman, and her niece, Sandra Crow.
