Marie Norman, 79, of Caldwell, was called home to the Lord on April 2, 2019, surrounded by family and loved ones. Visitation will be held Thursday, April 4, at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home from 5 to 7 pm with Rosary recited at 7 pm. Mass of a Christian burial will be 2 pm Friday, April 5, at St. Mary's Catholic Church. Father Jesse Martinez and Fr Bernard Hung will preside over services. Burial will follow at Caldwell Masonic Cemetery.

Marie was born on January 9, 1940 in Caldwell, TX to Charlie and Hermina (Maresh) Slovak. She was a life long member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Caldwell. She graduated from Caldwell High School, class of 1959.

On November 26, 1960 she was married to John E. Norman, by Rev. Father V. A. Svercik. They were married for 32 years before John died in March 1992.

Marie worked for Keller Furniture from 1965 to 1989, then as Executive Director for Caldwell Housing Authority from 1989 to 2018. She served as election judge for the school board elections for 20 years. Marie taught CCE and was CCE coordinator at St. Mary's Catholic Church for 32 years. She also served two terms on St. Mary's Parish General Committee, was a member of St. Mary's Women's Club, and sang with the St. Mary's choir. Marie was a Eucharistic Minister and a Rosary Society member.

She was preceded in death by her husband, John Norman Sr.; her parents, Charlie and Hermina Slovak; her sister, Bernice; two brothers, Joe and Vincent; five half-brothers, Charlie, Laddie, Ernest, Louis and Robert Slovak; a

half-sister, Martha Slovak; sister-in-law's, Pat Blaha, Ruth Slovak, Linda Allen and Betty Goats; and brother-in-law's, James and Charles Norman.

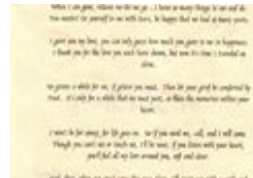
