Funeral services for Marilyn Davis, 79 of Giddings, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 19, 2022 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Pastor Robert Tiner and Vicar Josh Hahn officiating. A graveside service will follow at 2:00 p.m. at Onion Creek Memorial Park in Austin. Marilyn Ann Davis was born on November 13, 1942 in Lexington, Texas to Ernest Walter and Emily Alfreida (Kasper) Patschke. She was baptized on November 20, 1942 at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington. On April 14, 1957, she confirmed her faith at St. James Lutheran Church and her confirmation verse was Psalm 27:1, "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?" She graduated from Lexington High School and worked at Texas Work Force Commission as a statistician. On September 11, 1966, she was married to Gerald Zoch at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington by Rev. Jon Siemsglusz. After his passing, she was married to Terry Davis on April 22, 2007 by Rev. Kevin Lentz. Marilyn loved sports. When she wasn't attending her children's and grandchildren's games or going to watch the Giddings Buffalos play, she was cheering on the Houston Astros and the UT Longhorns.

She also enjoyed cooking, traveling, listening to polka, and meeting up with her girlfriends. Marilyn was active in the Giddings community and volunteered her time at Rejuvenation and served on the Christian Care Committee at Immanuel. She was always willing to help any organization in need.

She passed away the morning of Monday, March 14, 2022 in Austin, Texas.
