



Marjorie "Marge" Ann Harkrider

September 1, 1939 - June 2, 2021

Funeral services for Marjorie "Marge" Harkrider, 81 of Loebau, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau with Rev. Garrett Smith officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Monday, June 7, 2021 from 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Monday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Marjorie Ann (Kruemcke) Harkrider was born on September 1, 1939 in Giddings, Texas to Edmund and Linna (Artmann) Kruemcke. She was baptized on October 1, 1939 by Rev. William Mueller and confirmed on March 25, 1953 by Rev. J. Fred Mgebroff at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. Marge graduated from Giddings High School, received her nursing degree from the Brackenridge Hospital School of Nursing through the University of Texas and her master's degree from East Texas State University in Commerce, Texas. On January 16, 1960, she was united in marriage to Francis Edward Harkrider at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. Marge was a longtime Registered Nurse in the Dallas area having worked at Boswell Orthopedic, Baylor Hospital and Methodist Hospital. She also taught Medical Assisting at the Health Magnet High School in Dallas. After retiring, Eddie and Margie moved to the family farm in Loebau in 1994. She was an active member of Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau where she was a

member of the Ladies Aid, volunteered with the church's annual Mother's Day picnic and folded the church service bulletins. Marge was also a volunteer with the Lutheran Braille Workers and was a proud member of the Brackenridge Hospital School of Nursing Alumni Association. She enjoyed traveling, reading, sailing, ranching, gardening and working in her flowerbeds, snow skiing, fishing and any other outdoor activities. She was also a huge UT football fan.

Marge passed away on Wednesday, June 2, 2021 at St. Joseph Health Regional Hospital in Bryan following a long fought battle against Corticobasal Degeneration.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Edmund & Linna Kruemcke, and her husband, Eddie Harkrider.

Marge is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Eddie & Melissa Harkrider of Loebau; three grandchildren, Cody Harkrider & his wife, Shelby of Loebau, Tyler Harkrider & his wife, Mandy of East Bernard, and Hailey Harkrider of College Station; three great grandchildren, Lukas, Kael, and Aiden Harkrider all of Loebau; her sister and brother-in-law, Barbara & Rex Crocker of Giddings; her uncle, Ed Artmann of Georgetown, as well as several nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

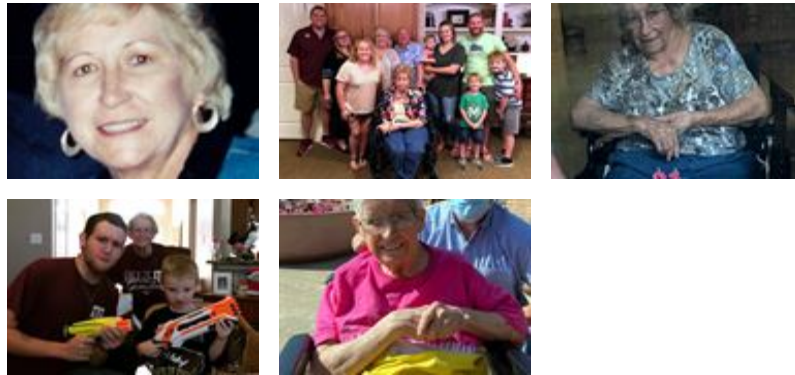

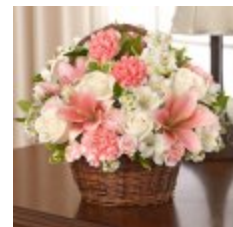
