Marshall Addington, 49, of Pflugerville, passed away Wednesday, July 1, 2015. Graveside services will be held on Friday, July 3, 2015 at the Minerva Cemetery just outside Rockdale. Marshall passed away Wednesday evening, July 1, 2015 in St. David's Hospital in Round Rock. He was preceded in death by his father, Roy Addington.
