



Marvin Charles Faske

January 4, 1931 - December 3, 2018

Funeral services for Marvin Faske, 87, of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, December 7, 2018 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Thursday, December 6, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Friday, December 7, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Faske family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Marvin Charles Faske was born on January 4, 1931 in Lincoln, Texas, the son of Charles August Faske and Esther Mathilda (Kappler) Faske. He was baptized on January 18, 1931 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. G.W. Fisher and confirmed on April 16, 1944 at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim, Texas by Rev. A.F. Michalk. His confirmation verse was Romans 8:32, "He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" Marvin joined the United States Navy on May 28, 1952 and served during the Korean Conflict. He received his Honorable Discharge on May 22, 1956 having obtained the rank of Engineman Second Class. Marvin worked as a mechanic for the City of Austin before transferring to the Austin Fire Department where he maintained the fire trucks and other equipment. After retiring in the 1980's, he moved back to Giddings. Marvin was a faithful member of Immanuel

Lutheran Church in Giddings. He was an avid hunter and fisherman and had been a member of the local Bass Club.

Marvin passed away the evening of Monday, December 3, 2018 at St. David's Medical Center in Austin.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Charles and Esther Faske; his brother and sister-in-law, Leonard & Lillian Faske, and two brothers-in-law, Clarence Medack and Floyd Markert.

Marvin is survived by his two sisters, Frances Medack of Giddings and Laverne Markert of Giddings; two brothers, James Faske and his wife, Jeanette of Conroe, and Elmer Faske and his wife, Ruth of Giddings, as well as several nieces, nephews, great nieces and great nephews.

Serving as pallbearers will be Adam Faske, Curtis Christiansen, Darrell Markert, Dennis Faske, Kenneth Faske, and James Medack.
