

Marvin Charles Fischer

July 1, 1933 - December 8, 2016

Funeral services for Marvin Fischer, 83, of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, December 12, 2016 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Jeremy Walloch officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Sunday, December 11, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Monday, December 12, 2016 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Marvin Charles Fischer was born on July 1, 1933 in Giddings, Texas, the only child of Ernest John Fischer and Minnie Louise (Weber) Fischer. He was baptized on July 1, 1934 at Waldeck Lutheran Church in Waldeck, Texas by Rev. Carl Baer and confirmed on March 30, 1947 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. S.T. Schroeder. His confirmation verse was Psalms 119:93, "I will never forget Thy precepts, for with them Thou hast quickened me." Marvin attended the Good Hope School in Lee County where he acquired the nickname "Rooster" Fischer which stuck with him throughout his life. He graduated from Giddings High School in 1950 and attended Blinn College. Marvin served in the United States Army as a radar operator during the Korean Conflict from October 14, 1953 until receiving his Honorable Discharge on October 6, 1955. Part of this time he was stationed in Japan. He was united in marriage to Magdalena "Lena" Selma Miertschin on November 27, 1958 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas by Rev. Arthur A. Arndt.

They were blessed with two children, Allan and Theresa. Marvin worked for the USDA-ASCS office for over 31 years, retiring in 1989. He was an active member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings where he served as an usher for over 53 years, held the offices of president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer on the church council, was an adult bible class leader and was a member of the Brotherhood and Men in Mission. Marvin enjoyed gardening, fishing and farming and ranching. Marvin will be remembered for his keen sense of humor and his ability to tell a good joke and always get a laugh.

Marvin passed away suddenly the afternoon of Thursday, December 8, 2016 at his home in Giddings.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Ernest & Minnie Fischer; his wife of 55 years, Lena Fischer; his parents-in-law, Martin & Selma Miertschin; his sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Erna & Jimmy Klander; two brothers-in-law, Paul Miertschin and Royce Zoch; his niece, Caryn Zoch Neumann; his nephew, Bobbie Klander and his great niece, Katherine Neumann.

Marvin is survived by his son, Allan Fischer of Giddings; his daughter, Theresa Carley of La Grange; his grandson, Colton Carley of Dallas; two sisters-in-law, Ruth Lorenz & her husband, Marvin of Northrup and Clara Zoch of Austin as well as several nieces and nephews, other relatives and friends.

Serving as pallbearers will be Tommy Lehmann, Larry Bittner, Ron Zoch, Daniel Fischer, Rocky Ullrich and Ray Maass.

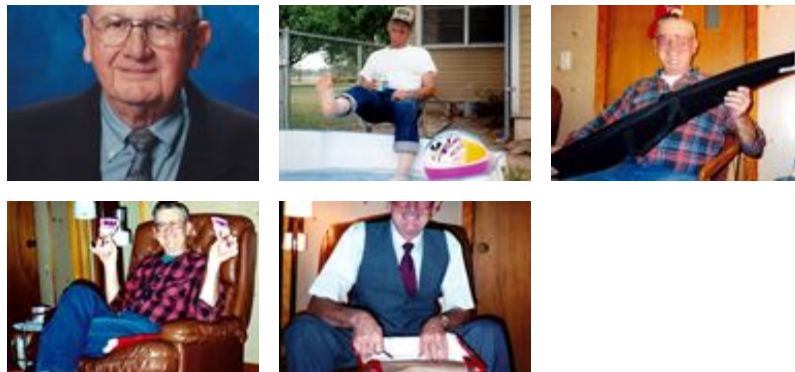
