He was baptized on May 6, 1928 by Rev. J.W. Behnken and confirmed in the Lutheran faith on March 29, 1942 by Rev. Oliver R. Harms. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII and received an Honorable Discharge in 1949. He was a retired supervisor with the Houston Independent School District as well as a Reserve Officer with the Harris County Sheriff's Department.
