



Marvin Gilbert Koslan

Funeral services for Marvin Koslan, 91, of Manheim, Texas, are scheduled for Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. at Ebenezer Lutheran Church in Manheim with Pastor John DeYoung officiating. Marvin Gilbert Koslan was born on September 25, 1934, in Manheim, Texas to Ben and Lina (Richter) Koslan. He was baptized on October 7, 1934, at Ebenezer Lutheran Church by Pastor Riech. Marvin was later confirmed on April 10, 1949, also at Ebenezer Lutheran Church by Pastor Paul G. Bruce. His confirmation verse was Colossians 3:17 "And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." Marvin attended school in Manheim and later received his GED and associate's degrees while serving in the United States Air Force. He was married to the love of his life Mabel (Grewe) Koslan on December 28, 1957, at St. John Lutheran Church in Hemet, California, by Rev. Hillmer. After leaving the Air Force Marvin settled in the Tomball area for some time where he was a Sunday School Superintendent. During his time in Tomball Marvin used his carpentry skills working as a handy man all around the Tomball area. He was also a postal carrier for the U.S. Postal Service for 28 years while living in Tomball.

Marvin passed away the evening of Thursday, March 19, 2026, at his home in Manheim with his family by his side.

He is preceded in death by his parents Ben and Lina Koslan, and brother-in-law, Marvin Wachsmann.

Mavin is survived by his wife of 68 years Mabel Koslan of Manheim; his son, Bruce Koslan of Manheim; his brother, Wilford and wife Janice Koslan of Giddings; his sister, Sylvia Jeanett Wachsmann of Tomball; his granddaughter, Megan and husband Mason Asher of Atlanta, Georgia; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and extended family.
