Marvin M. Sides, 102, of San Antonio, formerly of Rockdale, passed away Friday, September 4, 2015. Funeral services are set for 10:00 am Thursday, September 10, 2015 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home with Pastor Lance Walch officiating. Burial with Masonic Rites will follow at Forest Grove Cemetery. Visitation will be from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm on Wednesday, September 9, 2015 at the funeral home.

Marvin was born on January 30, 1913 in Milam County to James W. Sides and Evie (Wooten) Sides. He grew up in the Forest Grove area in southern Milam County and married Gladys Richards in 1934. He worked as a Milam County farmer until WWII, and then worked in construction, participating in the construction of the Lake Texoma dam in north Texas. On completion of that job, he began working in south Texas oilfields, beginning a 32 year career with Sun Oil Company in oil and gas production that over the years took him to the Texas towns of Freer, Bruni, Hebbronville, Corpus Christi, Kermit, and Premont, where he retired in 1978. Marvin returned to Rockdale in 1980 and lived there until moving into an assisted living home in the San Antonio area in 2011. He was a member of the Rockdale Masonic Lodge, and had been a Mason for over 60 years of his life. He was a member of the Forest Grove Christian Church for over 85 years.

Marvin's first wife Gladys Richards Sides passed away in 1980. He remarried,

to Eva Weems, in 1983, and they were together until her death in 2008.

He is preceded in death by each of his wives, Gladys Richards Sides and Eva Weems Sides; daughter, Patricia Sides Moreland in 1993; grandsons; Clayton Moreland and Derrick Moreland; parents, James W. and Evie Sides; brothers, James Sides and Howard Sides; and sisters, Clara Johnson, Marie Harrison, Madie Walker and Raye Ledwell.

Marvin is survived by his son, James B. Sides and wife Rosie of San Antonio, Texas; grandsons, James M. Sides of San Antonio, Texas and Jim Moreland of Los Angeles, California; great grandchildren, Christopher Moreland, Zachary Sides and Regan Sides; and nephews, Robert Sides, Kenneth Sides and Johnny sides all of Rockdale, Texas.
