Mary L. Beyer, age 76, long time resident of Rockdale, passed away Tuesday evening, October 1, 2019 in the Winnie L. Nursing Center in Cameron, after a sudden illness.

Services will be 10:00 a.m. Saturday, October 5, 2019 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with Rev. John Seaton of St. John's United Methodist Church officiating.
