Funeral services for Mary Kay Herms, 71 of Paige, Texas, are scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on Monday, July 24, 2023, at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings, with Tim Pitts officiating. Burial will follow in Ridgeway Cemetery in Paige. Mary Kay (Meuth) Herms was born on December 13, 1951, in Giddings, Texas, the daughter of Albert and Katie (Kunschick) Meuth. She attended school in Bastrop and graduated from Bastrop High School in 1970. Mary Kay was united in marriage to Herman Roy Herms on January 27, 1973, in Paige, Texas. They had one daughter, Christine. She worked at the Paige Post Office for 30 years. In 2004, she and Roy opened Lost Pines Barbeque. Originally starting in Bastrop, they eventually moved the business to Giddings in 2009. A lifelong Catholic and was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Pin Oak. Mary Kay's faith was always an important part of her life. She enjoyed gardening, sewing, and fishing. She will be remembered as a loving, caring, and devoted wife, mother, and nana.

With her family by her side, Mary Kay passed away on Wednesday, July 19, 2023, at her home in Paige, following a hard fought, five year battle against

cancer.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Albert & Katie Meuth; her brother, Nelson Meuth; her sister, Shirley Harrell; two nieces, Judy & Crystal, and her parents-in-law, Bruno & Erna Herms.

Mary Kay is survived by her husband of 50 years, Roy Herms of Paige; her daughter, Christine Elsenburg & Paul Heigh of Paige; her two grandchildren, Mason Elsenburg and Madison Elsenburg both of Paige, as well as several cousins and many friends.

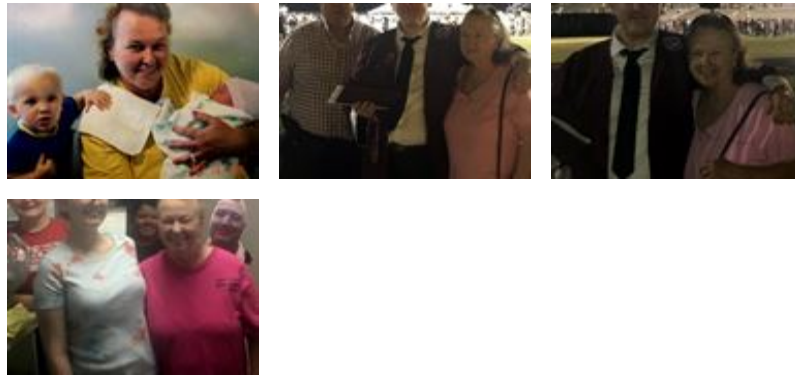

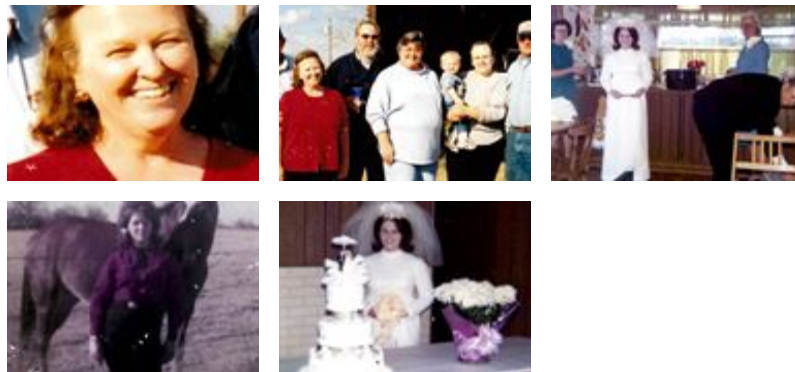
