Mary Helen Meza was born on August 21, 1953 in Corpus Christi, Texas to Walter and Maria Elena (Segovia) Meza. She married Ambrosio Castelo Perales Jr. and shortly after gave her life to the lord. Mary gave her life to the lord under a tent in Corpus Christi as a young lady with her children. She started telling people about Jesus Christ of Nazareth by passing out tracks in the park. Mary would say, Where does Jesus Live? "In your heart", and Who loves you? "Jesus loves you". She lived a life of holiness and dedication to Jesus Christ. She joined the New Testament Holiness Church in Bangs, Texas in 1978 with Pastor Barron, where she met Pastor Anni Ruth Scurlock, and they became lifelong friends. She took her next step into her ministry into Madisonville. She never stopped; she hit the ground running, telling people even more about Jesus and how he saved her life. She was a dedicated member of the Church of Jesus Christ in Dime Box. She was in a severe accident which should have taken her life in April of 2000. By the grace of God, she survived and devoted her life to telling everybody about the miracle that God had done for her. She would translate in street services for Evangelist Andre Walker and Ron Jones. She never wasted an opportunity to tell somebody about the love of Jesus and how he could save your soul. She

was a hard-working woman and a devoted and loving mother to her children, grandchildren, and great granddaughter. Most of all she loved the Lord with all her heart and believed anything was possible through Christ Jesus. Her greatest legacy was supporting missions and winning souls.

Mom went to be with the Lord on Sunday June 2, 2024; surrounded by her family and pastor Jackie Gray.

She was preceded in death by her parents Maria and Walter Meza, and her baby brother Joey.
