



## Mary Ann Nieto

March 25, 1929 - April 6, 2020

Long time Milam County resident, Mary Ann Nieto, age 91, passed away early Monday morning, April 6, 2020 in the Double Creek Assisted Living in Round Rock.

Mary Ann Nieto was born March 25, 1929 in Sharp, Texas to Ignacio and Anita (San Miguel) Munoz. She graduated from Sharp High School. After graduation she went to nursing school in San Antonio and worked as a nurse until 1955 when she and Heraclio Eddie Nieto were married on June 11, 1955 in Sharp. She then became a devoted wife and homemaker and continued to nurse. They moved to Rockdale where she lived from 1955 until 2002, when she moved to Round Rock with her son and daughter-in-law. After she retired from nursing, she became a department manager with the Rockdale Walmart for 17 years. Mrs. Nieto was a member of the First Baptist Church and Meadowbrook Baptist Church in Rockdale.
