



Melvin Marvin Schulze Sr.

March 30, 1934 - October 16, 2023

Funeral services for Melvin Schulze, 89 of Serbin, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 19, 2023 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion Post 276, will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, October 18, 2023 from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, October 19, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Wednesday afternoon from 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Melvin Marvin Schulze was born at home in Bastrop County, Texas on March 30, 1934. He was the son of August Andreas Schulze and Mathilde Helene (Noack) Schulze. He was baptized on April 8, 1934 and confirmed on March 30, 1947 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt. His confirmation verse was Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek". He joined the United States Army on December 7, 1956 and received his Honorable Discharge on December 1, 1958, having obtained the rank of SP4. Melvin was united in marriage to Eleanor Ruby Schroeder on November 14, 1959 at Grace Lutheran Church in Smithville, Texas by Rev. Adolph F. Michalk. He worked as a machinist, first with Blue Flame, and eventually retiring from the LCRA as a machinist supervisor. Melvin was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin and

the Giddings American Legion York Post 276. He enjoyed playing dominoes and Skat, Polka dancing, fishing and riding around on his tractor.

Melvin passed away the afternoon of Monday, October 16, 2023 at Ascension Seton Northwest Hospital in Austin.

He was preceded in death by his parents, August and Mathilde Schulze; a brother, Clarence Schulze, and two sisters, Mildred Schulze and one as an infant.

Melvin is survived by his wife of 63 years, Eleanor Schulze of Serbin; three children, Clifford Schulze and his wife, Juli of Prosper, Melvin Schulze Jr. and his wife, Teresa of Johnson City, and Sandra Garrett and her husband, Glenn of Burnet; four grandchildren, Melissa Broch and her husband, Kevin of The Colony, Grant Garrett & his wife, Jordan of Bee Caves, Brandon Garrett of Austin, and Jenna Sager and her husband, Matt of Kyle; six great grandchildren, Katie Forbes, Kamryn Sager, Kloey Forbes, Killian Sager, Witten Broch, and Kamryn Broch, and one brother, Alfred Schulze and his wife, Nancy of Serbin.

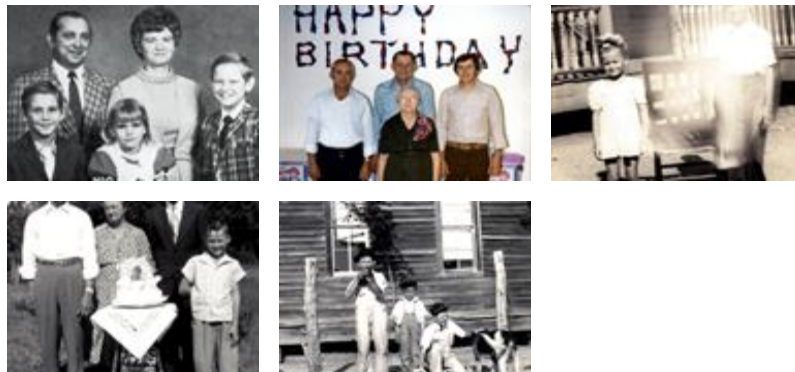
