



Michael Anthony Temeyosa

February 3, 1968 - July 3, 2023

Funeral services for Michael Anthony Temeyosa, 55 of Giddings, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m., Saturday, July 8, 2023 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Pastor Jim Moore officiating. Burial will follow at the Giddings City Cemetery. Military honors provided by American Legion York Post 276 in Giddings. Visitation will be held on Saturday, July 8, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home.

Michael Anthony Temeyosa was born on February 3, 1968 at the United States Naval Hospital in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, to the late Rosendo Temeyosa and Mildred Hiilei Wana Temeyosa. He was a United States Marine Corps Veteran who honorably served his country for nearly 10 years, serving in Operation Desert Storm during the Gulf War. A few of his duty stations included; MCRD San Diego, CA, Camp Lejeune, NC, Quantico, VA, Camp Pendleton, Kaneohe Bay, HI, and Parris Island, SC. Decorations, Medals, Badges, Citations, and Campaign Ribbons Awarded; 1987-1996, Good Conduct Medal w/2 Stars (every 3yrs), 1991 Combat Action Ribbon, Navy Unit Commendation, National Defense Service Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon, Southeast Asia Service Medal w/2 Stars, and Kuwait Liberation Medal. Michael was honorably discharged in 1997 from the United States Marine Corps with the rank of Sergeant. Michael was employed with Alpha and Omega Integration as a Senior Network Engineer. Previous employment was as a federal contractor for which he traveled to numerous

countries assisting on various mission assignments, receiving numerous accolades for his outstanding performance (in particular) during a hostage crisis that resulted in the safe recovery of our American citizens stating, "It is significant to mention that during this intense period of over 30 days, your network communications system was perfect." Michael was a fun, thoughtful, caring, and a loving husband, father, grandfather, son, brother, uncle, and friend to many, who was selfless in many ways, always going over and beyond for his family and friends. He was of Pentecostal faith and loved spending time with his family, writing poetry, singing, listening to Journey, playing video games, watching movies, doing photography and videography, sightseeing when traveling across the globe on his mission assignments, and bringing back various mementos for his family to treasure.

Michael ascended into heaven with his wife by his side on Monday, July 3rd, 2023 at the Baylor Scott and White Hospital ICU Unit in College Station, Texas.

He was preceded in death by his father, Rosendo Temeyosa in 2021, his mother, Mildred Wana Temeyosa in 1987, his sister, Yolanda Temeyosa in 1988, his brother, Mark Temeyosa in 2002, and nephew, Jonathon Mark Roberts in 1985.

Michael is survived by his wife, Irene R. Temeyosa; three daughters, Kimberly A. Knight (David), Shawna L. Williams, and Angela M. Shelton (Willie); son, James H. Williams, Jr. (Susan); two sisters, Mary A. Roberts (Stephen) and Katherine L. P. Garcia (Randall); two brothers, Luke P. 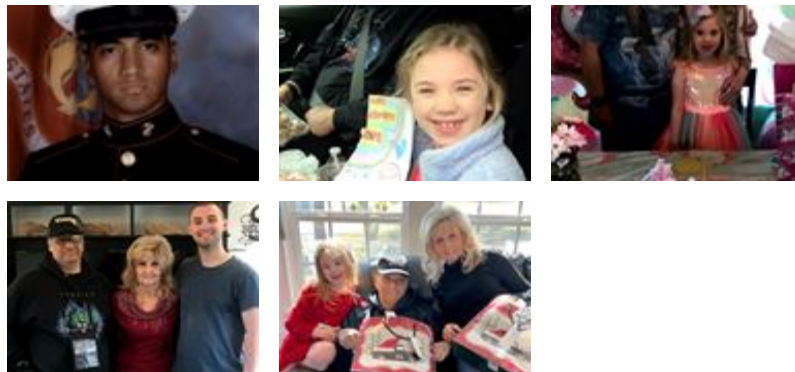

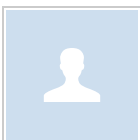
