Michael Glenn Thompson was born on July 3, 1953 at North Houston Memorial Hospital to Bobby and Hildagard Thompson. He passed away on March 6, 2021 surrounded by his family after a long, hard-fought battle with cancer.

Mike was baptized at Saint John's Lutheran Church in Caldwell, TX at the age of 12. He was baptized and confirmed into the Catholic Faith at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Bryan, TX in 1971. He was a man of strong faith and loved Jesus, never questioning the Almighty even during times of great suffering. He set an example to his family and all who knew him what it meant to be a Christian.

Mike and his wife Carol Everett were married at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Bryan, TX on September 2, 1972. He and Carol were truly life partners. They had two daughters, Dana Kristen Spacek and Amy Kathryn Fritcher.

Mike had an entrepreneurial drive. He began his working career at General Telephone and held many positions over the 14 years, from facilities, cable splicing, budget analyst and finally as the budget director before deciding to start his first business. His first venture was Master Turf Sprinkler Systems. He installed many of the sprinkler systems in businesses and homes around the Caldwell area. Mike then decided he always enjoyed meat processing and

making sausage and went to Texas State Technical College and got his degree in Meat Processing and Marketing. Soon afterwards, the construction of Circle T Meat Market and BBQ was started. He and Carol owned and operated Circle T from 1988 to 1993. They made the best BBQ around and Friday nights were steak night. People still talk about those amazing steaks. He also started processing deer for his many customers. It was his sausage recipe that carried him into his next business. Texas Chaw Meat Products opened in 1997 with his son in law Floyd Fritcher, Jr. They made sausage for Central Texas grocery stores and continued to make a lot of deer sausage every fall. He retired in 2016 after selling Texas Chaw Meat Products.

His retirement years brought him his greatest joys and that was spending time with his three grandchildren, Kaitlyn & Barrett Spacek and Grace Fritcher. He and Carol never missed one of their many activities and knew all about the happenings in their daily lives. He and Carol also spent time traveling. They loved to cruise. His favorite trip was too Alaska and was most excited to fly over Mount McKinley. They went to the East Coast and spent several days exploring Massachusetts and taking the fall foliage cruise to Canada. Their last cruise was one that began in Miami, down the East coast of Central America, through the Panama Canal and up the West coast finally docking in San Diego. It was a long trip but a great trip, seeing many places and spending good times with friends.

He was always an avid gardener, loved farming and ranching, and of course, Aggie Football. His best times in his later years were spent taking care of his cattle and pastures and spending time with his beloved blue heeler, Aggie. Anyone who came across Mike & Aggie, knew immediately that Mike was her guy and to keep their distance. She was his protector and loved him dearly.

Mike will be remembered as a fabulous dancer, two steps, polkas and waltzes, it didn't matter. Carol often had to share him with his daughters,

granddaughters and their friends that would “fight” for a dance with Mr. Mike. His many stories, jokes, infectious laugh and good food will be missed by all who knew and loved him.

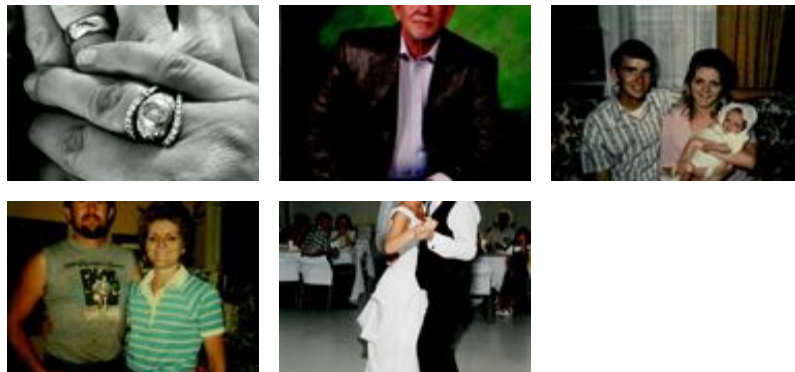

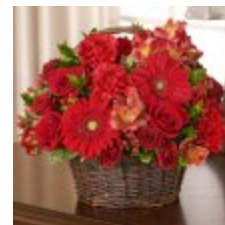
