Miguel Arguello-Zuñiga, 65, of Caldwell, Texas passed away on Thursday, July 8, 2021 in La Hincada, San Luis Potosi, Mexico. A public visitation will be held on Wednesday, July 14, from 5 to 7 pm in the Chapel of Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Caldwell, rosary will begin at 7 pm. A Funeral Mass in his honor will be July 15 at 11:00 am at St. Mary's Catholic Church, followed by interment at St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery.

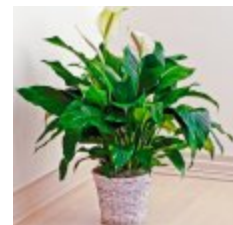
