



Mildred Irene Symmank

August 21, 1936 - April 26, 2018

Funeral services for Mildred Symmank, 81, of Lincoln, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, April 30, 2018 at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington, Texas with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Committal services will follow at 2:00 p.m. at St. John Lutheran Cemetery in Lincoln. Visitation will be held on Sunday, April 29, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, April 30, 2018 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Mildred Irene (Beisert) Symmank was born at home around 5:00 am on August 21, 1936 in Loebau, Texas to Martin & Clara (Kasper) Beisert. She was baptized at Christ Lutheran Church on August 30, 1936 by Pastor W.H. Rummert and confirmed on April 10, 1949 at Christ Lutheran Church by Pastor Herbert Hartfield. Her confirmation verse was John 10:27-28. "My sheep listen to my voice: I know them, and they follow me. I will give them eternal life and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand".

She married Clarence Victor Symmank on October 5, 1957 in Loebau, Texas at Christ Lutheran Church by Pastor Herbert Hartfield. After getting married, she and Clarence moved to Houston where they started and worked together on their drywall business. They had three sons, Allan Anthony, Keith Nathan

and Christopher Vincent. While in Houston, they were active members at Immanuel Lutheran Church. She was a Cub Scout leader for her older boys and focused on athletics with Chris and acted as a class mom/chaperone thereafter. Once the boys were older, she worked with Clarence for several years at their drywall company and retired early to help care for her in-laws when their health began to fail. After building a home in Lincoln, Texas in the early 2000's, they split their time between Houston during the week for business and Lee County for social functions on the weekends. She loved her weekend time in Lee County and looked forward to all the activities each month that occurred as a result of coming from such a large and close-knit family.

Mildred was very active and loved being outdoors. She was a big fan of the Houston Astros. She enjoyed deer hunting for years and only gave it up when the family left the lease in Mason in the late '90's. Mildred is best remembered for loving her large extended family and being the honorary record keeper of all the family details. She made a point to attend most all family events and holiday functions throughout the year as part of this effort and kept books with written details of dates, names, etc.

Mildred passed away the morning of April 26, 2018 at Memorial Hermann Hospital – Memorial City in Houston, TX following complications from a stroke.

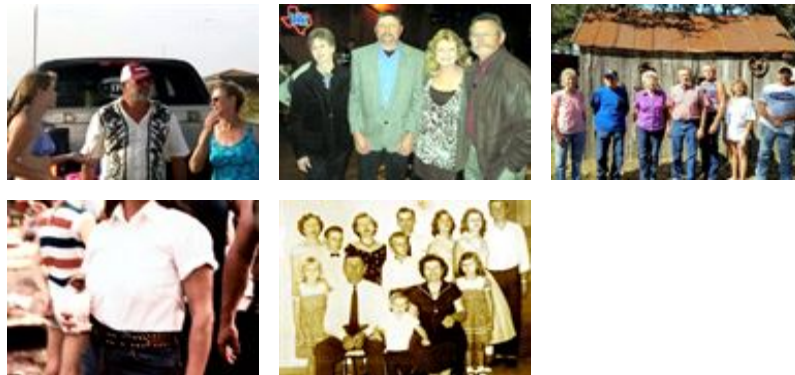
