



## Mildred Wiederhold

February 6, 1930 - August 15, 2020

Funeral services for Mildred Faye (Milburn) Wiederhold, 90, of Dime Box are scheduled for Wednesday, August 19, 2020 at 10:00 am at St. John Lutheran Church in Dime Box with Pastor Joseph Leavengood and Pastor Terry Bage officiating. Burial will follow in the St. John Lutheran Cemetery in Dime Box. Visitation will be held at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings on Tuesday, August 18, 2020 from 10:00 am until 8:00 pm. The family will be present from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Mildred was born on February 6, 1930 in Giddings, the daughter of Richard and Erna (Seelke) Milburn. She was baptized February 23, 1930 and confirmed April 18, 1943 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Walter G. Tillmanns. She attended school in Giddings through the 8th grade. After school she helped her parents, brothers, and sisters on the farm. Mildred was united in marriage to Ervin Ernest Wiederhold on April 25, 1954 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. They started their life together in Dime Box. They were blessed with three sons, Dwane, Doyle, and Douglas.

Together Mildred and Ervin built and ran Wiederhold Meat Market in Dime Box, until Ervin's death on December 28, 1981. Doyle and his wife Danita then ran the market until Doyle's death in 2000. After Mildred retired from the meat market, she enjoyed taking trips with her sisters to Sinton. She sang in the church choir, grew flowers, and tended to her vegetable garden and

chickens. She loved to dance and listen to music, liked canning her vegetables, baking, and loved and cherished her faithful canine companion, Sam. Mildred also liked to sew and make quilts and enjoyed playing bingo.

Mildred resided at Burleson St. Joseph Manor after declining health. She had been at the manor since October 17, 2013. Mildred entered into her Savior's arms on Saturday, August 15, 2020.

She is preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Ervin; son, Doyle; eight sisters, Inez Hill, Dorothy Mae Milburn, Nora Hohle, Clara Kruemcke, Ann Farr, Leona Hannes, Lois Marburger, and Irene Grimm, and four brothers, Joe Milburn, Grady Milburn, Richard Milburn, and Malcolm Milburn.
