



## Minnie Mae Ruth Schulze

July 3, 1935 - September 27, 2019

Funeral services for Minnie Mae Schulze, 84, of Serbin, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 1, 2019 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Monday, September 30, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, October 1, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Monday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Minnie Mae Ruth (Noack) Schulze was born on July 3, 1935 in Serbin, Texas, the daughter of Gerhard J. and Hermine M. (Weise) Noack. She was baptized on July 14, 1935 and confirmed on March 21, 1948 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Paul C. Eifert. Her confirmation verse was Luke 10:42 "But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her". She attended grade school at St. Paul Lutheran School in Serbin and graduated from Giddings High School in 1952. Minnie Mae was united in marriage to Eldor Edwin Schulze on July 3, 1955 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Arndt. Their marriage was blessed with twin daughters, Brenda and Linda. Shortly after their marriage, Minnie Mae and Eldor moved to Houston where they were members of St. Mark's Lutheran Church and Minnie Mae worked in bookkeeping at a department store. After moving back to Serbin in 1975, Minnie Mae worked at Perry's. She attended St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin where she was a

member of the Ladies Aid. Minnie Mae was also involved with taking tapes of the church services to the area nursing homes and church members who were unable to attend services. She also volunteered her time with the local food pantry and at the local nursing homes. Minnie Mae enjoyed playing dominoes, gardening, and taking care of the flowers in her yard. She like to visit with her friends, especially over the telephone. She was an excellent seamstress and made all of her daughters' clothes up until they reached high school. She was particularly proud of the fact that all four of her granddaughters attended Texas A & M University. In addition to being a loving and devoted mother and grandmother to her daughters and granddaughters, she will also be remembered for her homemade pickles and coffee cake.

Minnie Mae passed away the morning of Friday, September 27, 2019 at the Heart Hospital of Austin following a sudden illness.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Gerhard & Hermine Noack; her husband, Eldor Schulze, and her brother, Clarence Noack.

Minnie Mae is survived by her two daughters and sons-in-law, Brenda & Robert Muniz of Serbin and Linda & Tommy Wilkins of Elgin; four granddaughters, Kristen Portales & her husband, Cody of Cypress, Kelsey Wachsmann & her husband, Ethan of Giddings, Kaitlyn Behrend & her husband, Cameron of Boerne, and Alyssa Wilkins of Elgin; one sister-in-law, Irene Noack of Serbin, as well as several nieces and nephews.

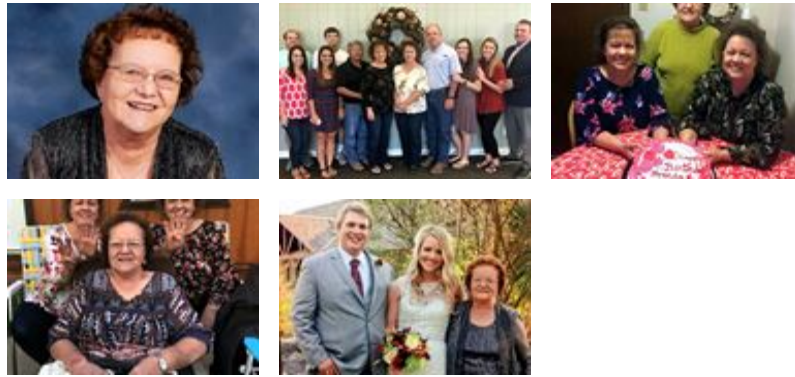
