



Monroe Herman Becker

May 14, 1933 - January 24, 2024

Funeral services for Monroe Becker, 90, of Serbin, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 28, 2024 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, January 27, 2024 from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Sunday, January 28, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Saturday evening from 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Monroe Herman Becker was born on May 14, 1933 in Serbin, Texas to Martin Ernst and Minnie Selma (Noack) Becker. He was baptized on May 21, 1933 and confirmed on April 14, 1946 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Herman Schmidt. He proudly served his country during the Korean Conflict in the United States Army. He received his Honorable Discharge on February 12, 1956, having obtained the rank of SP4. Monroe was united in marriage to Verna Mae Boettcher on January 3, 1954 at Waldeck Lutheran Church by Rev. A.T. Kluge. They were blessed with four children, Allan, Allene, Donald, and Beverly. Shortly after their marriage, Monroe & Verna Mae moved to Houston where he worked at National Flame. After retiring, they moved back to Serbin in 1983. Monroe was a faithful member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin where he had served as an Elder. He was active in the Giddings American Legion York Post 276 where he had served as Commander and

was a member of the Honor Guard. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, working on the farm, and taking care of his cattle. He will be remembered for his commitment, love and faithfulness to his family, his church, and his country.

Monroe passed away the evening of Wednesday, January 24, 2024 at the Towers Nursing Home in Smithville.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Martin & Minnie Becker; his wife of 66 years, Verna Mae Becker; his son-in-law, David Schramm; his granddaughter, Brianna Nichole Becker; two brothers and sisters-in-law, Marvin & Alice Becker and Elbert & Adele Becker; his parents-in-law, Albert & Edna Boettcher; one brother-in-law, Winston Boettcher Sr. and a nephew, Jimmy Becker.

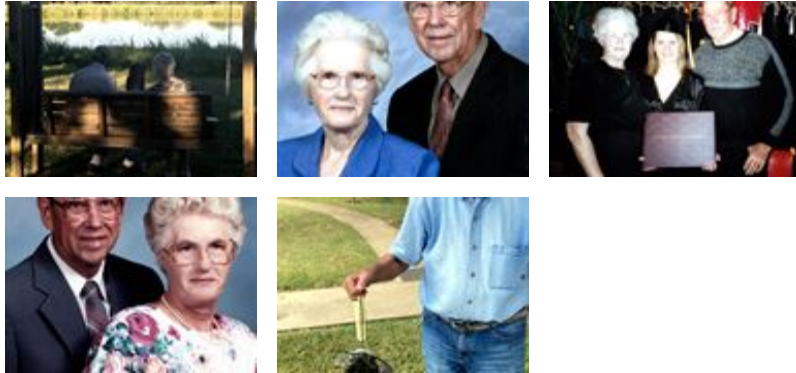
