



Myron Schneider

August 31, 1953 - January 4, 2020

Myron Everett Schneider was called home to be with his heavenly Father on January 4, 2020 in his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 66 years old.

Funeral services for Myron Schneider will be held at 2:00 PM, Tuesday, January 7, 2020 at the Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale with Pastor Jonathan Meyer of St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington officiating, burial will follow in the Murray Cemetery near Rockdale. Visitation will be held Monday, January 6, 2020 at Phillips & Luckey from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM.

Myron was born Aug 31, 1953 in Fort Leonard Wood, MO to Ernest Rudolf Schneider and Vernell Gertrude Schneider. He was baptized into the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod as an infant and remained true to the faith throughout his life. He grew up in Rockdale and graduated Rockdale High School in 1971.

In 1977 he married Patti Luckey and together they raised 4 children. In 1986 they began a Mom & Pop hydroponic greenhouse business partnership that supplied Austin area HEB's with top quality tomatoes for 33 years.

Myron was a quiet passionate man with a strong resolve, great sense of humor, and a deep Christian faith. He was self-taught. Not only did he single

handedly build their family home, he also built all greenhouses and barns. He taught himself to be an excellent hydroponic farmer.

His hobbies were hunting, fishing, and baseball and he was always trying to improve these in every way. Whether it be his ever-expanding floating dock on his beloved Lake Ernest, or continually improving the deer and hog stands and traps, each one better than the last. He spent countless hours learning how to tweak what came naturally to him as an athlete to teach young pitchers the art of baseball. He coached baseball and softball for nearly 40 years.

His hobbies brought him great joy, but the greatest love of his life were his children. He had a unique way of tapping into each one's special gifts and abilities, and making them feel treasured in their own way. He embraced his new role as grandfather as he did with everything else in life.. with gusto and intention, earning him the nickname "Turbo" -which was very fitting.

To fill the void left by his children leaving home, he developed a new sense of purpose in helping his parents care for his handicapped nephew. He derived great pleasure in bringing him comfort and easing his pain.

Myron was preceded in death by his father, Ernest, in Feb 2019, sister Valerie, in Jan 2019, and nephew Colby Tasler in March 2018.

Myron is survived by his wife, Patti of Rockdale. Daughter Cne' Schneider of Austin. Son Ty and Nicole Schneider of Buda, Daughter Trish and Jake Ammon of Jacksonville Florida, and Son Duke and Gabby Schneider currently living in the Middle East. Grandchildren are Trevor and Veda Ammon, Ellie Schneider, and Mason Schneider - Due to arrive next week. His devoted mother Vernell Schneider of Rockdale, Sister Sandra Drake and Tom of Rockdale, and sister Joan Love of San Antonio. plus, numerous nieces and nephews.

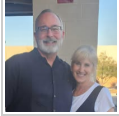

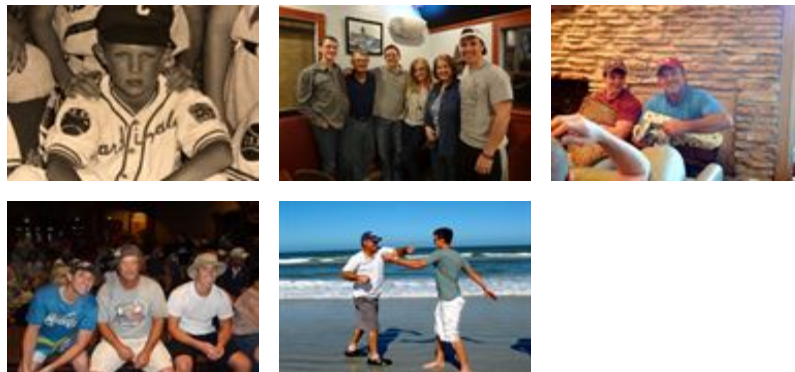

My family had the good fortune to be involved with this family during our kids baseball days, and Myron and I coached baseball teams together in Round Rock.

I was always amazed Myron would drive Duke and hour both ways from Rockdale to Round Rock for so many practices and games, only because he wanted his son to have the best possible baseball experience possible. Of course it's important to note that Patti made that same trip many, many times.

I can remember like it was yesterday how Myron would pitch batting practice to the whole team until they couldn't take anymore, and I mean throwing hard. Myron was country strong, so throwing a few hundred pitches was nothing for him. At least he never showed it.

Myron was not a boisterous man, he let his actions speak for him, and his actions spoke loudly and still resonate with me. He was extremely respectful of the players on our team as well as the opponents team, always quick to praise them for doing things the right way.

My favorite memory of Myron is how much his eyes sparkled when Duke would have one of his usual great games, particularly if it resulted in a win. Duke was a talented ball player, but his competitive nature got the best of him sometimes, and Myron would sidle up to me in the dugout and tell me to “go get after him” . Myron didn't want me to go hug him, he wanted me to put a boot on his rear end, and I did.

Myron knew that it would mean more coming from me, because we all learn to ignore our parents! I always appreciated that he trusted me to be the bad guy sometimes, and I trusted him the same way with my son.

I will always treasure my memories of Myron, he loved his family more than life itself and it showed in everything he did. I am proud that he considered me his friend.

Godspeed Myron, thank you for touching our lives.
