



## Myrtle Loree Locklin

June 24, 1916 - December 11, 2017

Services for Myrtle Loree Locklin, 101, of Lexington, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 PM on Sunday, December 17, 2017 at the Lexington United Methodist Church with Rev. Trey Comstock officiating. Burial will follow in the Lexington Cemetery. Myrtle Loree (Rodgers) Locklin was born June 24, 1916 in the Phears Community north of Lexington, Texas to Joseph Sorrell Rodgers and Lula Maude (Smith) Rodgers. There were no buses to Lexington at that time so she continued classes for three more years and assisted teaching when their teacher was ill. Myrtle enjoyed singing in the Lexington United Methodist choir and participating in the United Methodist Women's group at church. She liked sewing, quilting, gardening, participating in all of Lexington's events, singing at the Senior Center, visiting with friends and spending time with her family.

Myrtle passed away the morning of Monday, December 11, 2017 in Houston, Texas.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Joe and Lula Rodgers; her husband, Edward; two daughters, Wiladene Meyer and Jo Ann Clawson; and nine siblings, Bewel Rodgers, Bethel Rodgers, Homer Rodgers, Ruby Leggett, Roy Rodgers, Marvin Rodgers, George Rodgers, Lola Maude "Doll" and Joseph Rodgers.
