One daughter was born to this union. Myrtle was a school teacher in Goodville, Bartlett and Lexington. In Rockdale she taught first grade in the same classroom for 29 years, retiring on May 31, 1982. She was a former owner of Love's Flower and Gift Shop in Rockdale from 1975 to 1989. She was a member of First Baptist Church, member at large of the Daughters of the American Revolution, member of Delta Kappa Gamma and a life member of the Crippled Childrens Camp of Kerrville. Myrtle passed away Monday morning, July 18, 2011 in the Cameron Nursing Center in Cameron, reaching

the age of 95. She was preceded in death by her husband Harold on August 21, 1998. Her parents. 3 brothers, Morris, Thomas and Moody Evans.
