



Nicholas "Nick" Michael Lombardo

December 2, 1950 - January 12, 2025

Funeral services for Nicholas "Nick" Lombardo, 74 of Dime Box, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 18, 2025 at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with Rev. Nicholas Michael Lombardo was born on December 2, 1950 in New Castle, Pennsylvania, the son of Nicola & Josephine Lombardo. He served in the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War. After receiving his Honorable Discharge in 1976, Nick moved to Texas where he sold pressure washers and other types of equipment for several years. He also owned and operated an auto repair shop and filling station in Dime Box and was a partner in Barefootz Grocery in Dime Box for several years. After being together for several years, Nick married Susan Kane on November 22, 2010. He was an active member of the Dime Box Volunteer Fire Department for many years. He will be remembered for his ability to fix almost anything mechanical and how he was always being willing to help others.

Nick passed away unexpectedly the evening of Sunday, January 12, 2025 at St. Joseph Health Burleson Hospital following a sudden illness.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Nicola & Josephine Lombardo; an infant sibling; his father-in-law, James Kane and his brother-in-law, Brian Kane.
