Noelle Christine Levantino was born on Tuesday June 29, 1999 in The Woodlands, Texas to Scott Thomas Levantino and Natalie Christine (Poerner) Levantino. She attended Sacred Heart Catholic School in Conroe and graduated from Montgomery High School in three years at the age of 16 (class of 2016). She was a junior high and high-school cheerleader, competitor on the girl's power lifting team, and active in tumbling. Noelle received her Bachelor of Science in Economics June 2020 from Texas A&M University in College Station. While a student, she was on the President's List at Blinn and Dean's list at Texas A&M. She was also a member of the Delta Zeta Sorority and attended St. Mary Catholic Church where she received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Noelle's career began in Houston immediately after college with Insight Global's information technology division. Within one year, she was promoted

from recruiter to account manager. Noelle piloted a new program that changed the landscape for how the company will promote people across the country in the future. She conducted the most client meetings while in a training program, got in the door to set meetings with senior executives, signed two client contracts that they had been trying to land for years, and created a sales and consulting framework before most seasoned account managers usually do. Noelle took initiative at learning and trying new things and would go above and beyond. She was incredibly impressive and had so many bright things ahead.

Noelle was known for being present and living in the moment, making every moment so much fun. Her contagious laugh and energy naturally drew people to her thus strengthening a special bond. She enjoyed so much in life including surrounding herself with friends and family, snowboarding, being outdoors, and dancing her heart out any chance she could while also incorporating her own signature moves. Noelle was motivated by the instinct to love, having tremendous love for God, family, friends, and her beloved Golden Retriever, Charli.

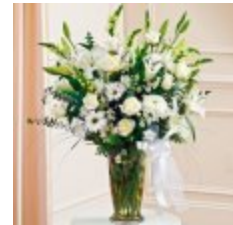
