

## Olivia Weiser Mize

February 26, 1940 - May 15, 2025

Funeral services for Olivia Weiser Mize, 85 of Lincoln, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 27, 2025 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln with Rev. Dale Bohm officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Monday, May 26, 2025 from 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, May 27, 2025 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Monday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Olivia Dorothy (Schulz) Weiser Mize was born on February 26, 1940 in Serbin, Texas, the daughter of Edwin Albert Schulz and Hermine Martha (Schulze) Schulz. She was baptized on March 3, 1940 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt and confirmed on April 11, 1954 also at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Arthur Arndt. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 27:1, "The Lord is my light and my salvation, whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life, of whom shall I be afraid?" Olivia was united in marriage to Martin L. Weiser on August 16, 1959 at St. Paul Lutheran Church by Rev. Arthur Arndt. They were blessed with three daughters, Norma, Nancy and Rose. Throughout her life, Olivia worked at the Giddings Dairy Queen, Paul's Grocery, the Lee County Farmer's Co-Op and Tiny Dreamers Daycare. All the while holding a fulltime job, she also took care of her cattle, raised and harvested pecans, and managed her farm. Her strong work ethic and determination to succeed was instilled in her family. Olivia

enjoyed playing dominoes, especially 42, and taught her grandchildren how to play straight dominoes as a way to teach them math skills at an early age. She always called family and friends in order to stay in touch with them and enjoyed being able to visit with them in person. She'll be remembered for how she always put her family first and how she always reminded them that "We may not have it all together, but together we have it all!" Olivia and her siblings "lived out loud" the dying wish of their own mother to "Take care of each other." May our family continue this legacy into future generations.

Olivia passed away the evening of Thursday, May 15, 2025 in Cypress, Texas.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Edwin & Hermine Schulz; her husband, Martin Weiser; her son, Stephen Weiser; her son-in-law, Larry Walch; her brother, Marvin Schulz, and her sisters and brothers-in-law, Adele & Robert Held, Alice & Wilbert Markert, and Viola & Leon Markert.

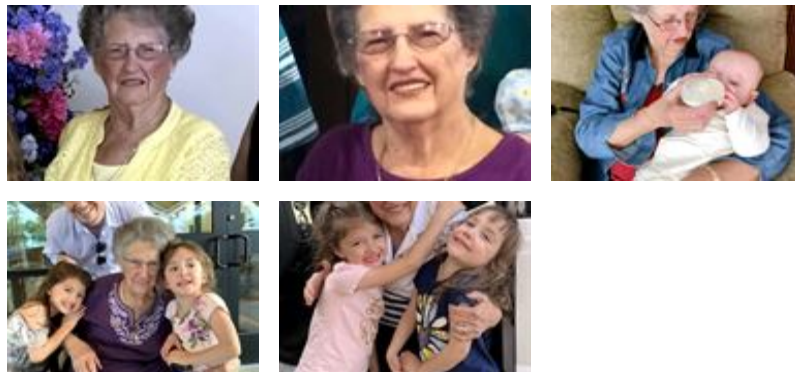

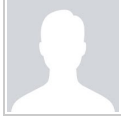
