



Ollivett Sheppard

September 22, 1923 - July 21, 2022

Graveside services for Ollivett Sheppard are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, July 29, 2022 at Sandy Point Cemetery in Dime Box, Texas, officiated by Rev. Avis Harris Caldwell. The viewing will be Thursday, July 28, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

On September 22, 1923, a girl was born to Mr. Wales Clemons & Mrs. Susie Collier Clemons. They named this baby Ollivett. Growing up she attended Fairview High in Dime Box, Texas, Freemon High in Caldwell, Texas, and Austin Community College in Austin, Texas where she trained to be a dietician. Ollivett united with Sandy Point A.M.E. Church at the age of 13. She remained a member of the church up until her death. Serving many years as the Sunday School Superintendent, Steward, Trustee, Treasurer, and Church Secretary. Ollivett is fondly remembered for her joy of gardening, quilting, working crossword puzzles, and taking care of her family and friends.

In 1943, she was united in marriage with Mr. Jake Lewis Jr. To this union nine children were born. In 1961, she married Mr. Ped Sheppard, who preceded her in death. Ollivett was also preceded in death by two daughters, Betty Hodge and Annie Lewis; one son, J.L.; her parents, and two sisters.

Ollivett Sheppard was received by the arms of the Lord on July 21, 2022 at

her home in Dime Box surrounded by her family.
