Oscar "Potsy" Wright Newcomb, 94, of Caldwell, Texas went to be with his Lord and Savior on Thursday October 6, 2022. A Celebration of Life service will be held in his honor at 10:30 AM on Saturday, October 15, 2022 at First Baptist Church in Caldwell, with Brother Shane Dismuke and Steve Johnson officiating. Interment with full Masonic Rites will follow at the Caldwell Masonic Cemetery.

Oscar "Potsy" Newcomb was born on February 20, 1928 to Fred Spires Newcomb and Lottie Duckworth Newcomb in Caldwell, Texas. He was one of seven siblings. Potsy graduated from Caldwell High School in 1945. He met the love of his life Celia P. Hettler in San Antonio, Texas and they were married August 5, 1950. To this union came John and Michael Newcomb. Soon after his high school graduation, Oscar began his college career but then decided to enlist in the United States Air Force where he achieved the rank of Chief Master Sargent. He retired in 1966. After his retirement he continued work in the data processing industry. Potsy was an avid golfer and member of Copperas Hollow Country Club. He was active in the First Baptist Church serving as a Deacon and Sunday school teacher in addition to many other activities within the church.
