Pablo Maldonado Martinez, 94, of Caldwell passed away in Bryan, Sunday, May 31, 2015. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held Friday, June 5, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. at St Mary's Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Caldwell, TX. Monsignor John McCaffrey will be Celebrant the burial will follow in the church cemetery. Military Honors will be presented by VFW Post # 4458. The family will receive guests from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. Thursday evening and the Holy Rosary will be recited at 7:00 p.m.

Pablo was born March 2, 1921 in Burton, Texas to parents Guillermo Martinez and Ascension (Maldonado) Martinez. He married Lucia Reyes November of 1943 in Washington County. He was a former member of St. Ann's Catholic Church in Somerville and a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church where he was a member of the Rosary Circle. He was also a member of VFW Post #4458. He served his country bravely during WWII serving in the United States Army as a private first class. He was a decorated soldier receiving a Purple Heart Medal, American Theater Campaign Ribbon, and Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Ribbon with Bronze Star, Philippine Liberation Ribbon with two Bronze Stars, Good Conduct Medal and a Victory Ribbon. He was a farmer for many years, he also enjoyed gardening, playing with his dogs "CoCo" and "Brownie" and spending time with family especially his grandchildren.

Mr. Martinez was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 65 years, Lucia Martinez, a daughter-in-law Geneva Martinez, 3 sisters, Aniceta Mercado, Louisa Fernandez, and Tiodosa Vasquez.

He is survived by his loving family 3 sons, Nonito Martinez and wife Elma of Cameron, TX., Lalo Martinez of Bryan, TX., and Tiodoro Martinez of Temple, TX., and a daughter, Severa "Vera" Pineda and husband Johnny of Caldwell, TX., and by 2 brothers, Graciano Martinez and wife Janie, and Inez Martinez both of Texas City, TX., also by numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren and great-great grandchildren, nieces, nephews other relatives and friends.
